#### From the Principal's Desk

Hello Parents, Carers and Community Members,

Welcome back to the action-packed start of Term 3!

Next week Classroom Teacher's have scheduled 'Goal Setting' meetings with those who have indicated their participation in the process. Having just received your child's semester one reports, teaching staff decided it was timely for children along with their carers to set goals to work toward.

The practice of students setting goals, recording them, along with tangible steps or commitments on their behalf supported by home and educators, proves to be highly effective. This builds reflective thinking about learning within students. We request that you discuss two goals with your child, that with your support, will be formalised on paper. The goal will be recorded during a three-way-goal-setting meeting, that will bring to your child's foremind what they can with concerted effort, work toward reaching. Regular check-ins at the dinner table, talking about your child's goals and how they are going working toward them, will support your child/children greatly. Your time slot of 15 minutes has been allocated for your child-parent-teacher 3-way Goal Setting meet if you indicated to participate. We look forward to the coming weeks and the children's progress. Any feedback as the process starts traction will be most welcome.

With your support, 100 Nights of Reading has begun to accelerate amongst the children again! This is wonderful to see, as the skill of reading improves future life-trajectories immensely. With daily home-school reading, the extra 10 minutes of home reading supports literacy growth at school. Diaries must be signed by a parent listener and a tally of nights kept in the home-diary. Monday Muster with Mrs Ball is when rewards are given for 25-50 and 75-night milestones. 100 Nights will be rewarded at Assembly with the children receiving their very own book, gifted from the school. Class and whole-school trackers of this nightly habit are being recorded.

This Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> of July, we have Crazy-Hair Day, so don't forget to get the hairspray and whacky ideas out for the luscious-locks! A gold coin donation is requested which will go toward the Leukaemia Foundation. The traditional whole school parade will kick off at 9am in the quadrangle, parents are welcome to hang-about and join in on the excitement!



We have a busy term ahead of us including a **Disco** on the 7th of September.











