Finally, thank you to all the competitors. We look forward to seeing everyone again in 2025.

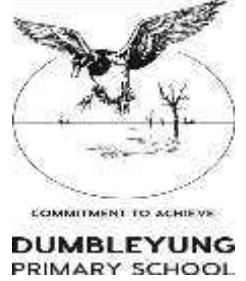
